

WHAT TO PACK FOR YOUR CONCERT

Before you continue, dancers on stage are **NEVER** to have:

JEWELLERY

nail polish

fake tattoos

Students must wear SKIN COLOURED underwear under their costumes.

STUDENTS ARE TO ARRIVE WEARING their own dance clothing. It is handy to wear a zip up jacket to not spoil hair. Please label all clothing and talk to your child about packing every item back in their bag as soon as they are done with it.

Every student will have their own costume bag waiting for them in their dressing room.

Your costume will be labeled with your child's full name and grade.

Costumes will be packed in order.

All costumes will be ironed /steamed.

*Yr2 and above please talk to your child about hanging costumes back up straight after wearing so they are still perfect for show 2 which will be filmed and photographed.

Any accessories or stockings will be packed in the back of your costume bag. Helpers on the day will remind students.

ADDITIONAL BAG - no larger than the size of a carry on suitcase. NO DREAM DANCE DUFFLES.

Little children will do best with a backpack they can wear. It is much easier for up and down stairs.

Inside this bag you should have:

All shoes required for your performances

A robe or jacket that zips in front, to wear whilst eating/waiting

Something to pass the time, book, colouring book with pencils only

Extra elastics, Bobby pins, safety pins, bandaids

A hair brush / comb

Hairspray

Baby wipes

A bottle of water (no soft drink, juice or coloured drinks)

Food / snacks

If you have any spare stockings in case of an accident.

Important:

No food is to contain nuts - this is very important due current students with allergies.

Food should be non greasy, non sticky, no colouring, is not messy or gets crumbs

everywhere. No fast food back stage. The best food to pack; apples, carrot or celery sticks, a sandwich/wrap.

Belongings get mixed up very easily, the best chance of them returning to you is to label everything. We do not recommend bringing any valuables back stage. C5 is not responsible for the loss of any belongings.
